First Home Buyer Checklist 2025

Are you ready to become a first home buyer in 2025?

A practical guide covering budgeting, deposit strategies, government schemes, and deciding whether to buy alone or with others.

1. Budgeting & money basics
 Work out how much you can afford to borrow and repay comfortably Review your income and expenses (set up a budget tracker) Reduce existing debts (credit cards, personal loans, buy now pay later) Build a savings buffer for unexpected costs (moving, maintenance, bills)
2. Deposit & savings strategy
 Check how much deposit you'll need by speaking to your mortgage broker Explore high-interest savings or offset accounts for your deposit Consider whether family support (e.g. guarantor loan, gifted deposit) is an option for you Look into alternatives like rent-to-buy or co-ownership arrangements
3. Government schemes & grants*
 Research the First Homeowner Grant (FHOG) in your state Check eligibility for the First Home Guarantee or Regional First Home Buyer Guarantee savings or offset accounts for your deposit Explore stamp duty concessions available in your state or territory Review any shared equity or low-deposit schemes
4. Deciding how to buy
 Weigh up buying alone vs with a partner/family/friends If buying with others, agree upfront on ownership shares and exit plans Think about whether to buy a home to live in or an investment first
5. Property & market prep
 Work with a mortgage broker to get pre-approval from a lender Research suburbs and property types that fit your budget Factor in extra costs such as legal fees, inspections, insurance and moving costs Be realistic about lifestyle trade-offs and consider factors like location vs property size vs features.
